M'AR De AR MURALHAS Hotel, Travessa da Palmeira, 4/6. 7000-546 Évora



Our conference base is the Four Star **M'Ar de Ar Muralhas Hotel**, in the historic heart of the city and set on the ancient city walls of Évora. It is a five minute walk to the famous Giraldo Square and Roman temple of Diana. There are 85 rooms and 6 suites, an extensive hotel garden, cosy bar areas and excellent restaurants. On site facilities include an outdoor pool and the "Sabores do Alentejo" restaurant where you can taste the innovative Alentejo gastronomy of Chef António Nobre. There is garage parking and street parking outside the hotel. Conference attendees will have full access to all hotel facilities.

The core conference programme runs from Friday 5 April evening drinks reception to dinner in the hotel on Sunday evening 7 April. Lunches do not include wine or drinks from the bar but do include water, tea and coffee. Dinner does include house red and white wine or sangria, beer, water, tea, coffee, soft drinks etc. Any other drinks should be paid for in cash or charged to your room.

Lunch and dinner will be buffet meals and our group has been allocated tables in the restaurant which has a lovely outlook over the hotel gardens and an extensive terrace.

Hotel accommodation includes breakfast in the hotel. There are also many restaurants & cafes close by. There is free Wi-Fi throughout the hotel. On request it will be possible to upgrade to a hotel suite opening onto the gardens. There is a secure hotel garage which should be reserved directly with the hotel.

Airport Transfers - the closest airport is Lisbon. Évora is approximately 1h 20 min drive from the airport. There is a good train service from the Lisbon Oriente station which takes approximately 1h 30 mins through the Alentejo countryside. Train tickets and seats can be booked online via <https://www.cp.pt/passageiros/en> Advance booking gives very generous discounts on already reasonable ticket prices. There is also an airport and rail shuttle service which can be reserved via the hotel.

If you wish to book your own alternative accommodation there is a selection available very close by at lower cost. If you would like any further details, please let us know. We can recommend the following but suggest that you book as soon as possible as Évora is a very popular destination year round :-

Évora is a lively University city, and classified as UNESCO world heritage. It is the capital of Portugal's south-central Alentejo region, famous for its cork oak forests (Montados). In the city's historic centre stands the ancient Roman Temple of Évora (the Temple of Diana). Nearby, whitewashed houses surround the Cathedral, a massive Gothic structure begun in the 12th century. The Igreja de São Francisco features Gothic and baroque architecture. There are many historic sites, arcaded streets and lovely green spaces, cafés and restaurants. The location of our hotel allows easy walking access to the historic centre of the city.

The University of Évora was the second university to be founded in Portugal. After the University of Coimbra in 1290, a second university was needed for the Southern part of the country. The inauguration took place on November 1st 1537, and the anniversary of the University is celebrated on that day. The main auditorium of the University in the historic Colégio Espírito-Santo will be the venue for our keynote speakers on Saturday morning, April 6.
